

# Wartburg College-Wartburg Foundation Agreement of Cooperation



Wartburg College has long cherished and maintained its relationship to its namesake, the Wartburg Castle. Wartburg College, its faculty, staff, students, and alumni, have held the history and traditions of the Wartburg Castle in high esteem. Since 1991, when Wartburg College first began to explore the possibility of establishing a closer and more formal relationship with Eisenach and the Wartburg Castle, the city-to-city, institution-to-institution, and, most importantly, the people-to-people exchanges have grown and intensified. In this spirit of international cultural exchange, Wartburg College and the Wartburg Foundation are entering into the following agreement of cooperation.

Let it be resolved that:

- 1 Wartburg College and the Wartburg Foundation shall be open to, encourage, and help arrange institutional and person-to-person exchanges and other visits involving staff of the Castle and faculty, staff, students, and alumni of the College;
- 1 The Wartburg College Choirs and Bands shall be permitted to perform in the Wartburg Castle on an annual basis, the details of which shall be arranged and agreed upon by both institutions, as the occasions arise;
- 1 Wartburg College and the Wartburg Foundation shall explore future possibilities for intercultural exchange and understanding through such activities as:
  - 1 Faculty, student, and staff study/course/internship opportunities at the College and the Castle.
  - 1 Regular video and radio broadcasts of Wartburg College Choir and Band performances at the Wartburg Castle.
  - 1 The development of a permanent Wartburg Castle exhibit on the Wartburg College campus, which will highlight the heritage of the Castle in the United States.
  - 1 The establishment of a Wartburg Castle room on the Wartburg College campus that houses Wartburg Castle resources and archives and serves as a formal meeting/reception place for Wartburg Castle- related events.
  - 1 The development of Internet sites and connections that enhance the relationship between Wartburg College and the Wartburg Foundation.
