The Board of Regents of Wartburg College has created a special recognition award, which will be known as The Wartburg Medal. The medal will be awarded by the College to recognize individuals who have provided significant service over a sustained period of time to the College. The Wartburg Medal recipients will be individuals who have a personal commitment to the College's mission, quality, and character. The Wartburg Medal, designed as a medallion of the College seal, will be bestowed at a formal academic convocation.

A maximum of three Wartburg Medals will be awarded each year at Opening Convocation. The medal can be awarded to alumni, friends, and retired faculty and staff who have demonstrated a personal commitment to the College's mission, quality, and character.

Any College employee may nominate a candidate for the Wartburg Medal. Although present College faculty, administrators, and staff are not eligible, emeritus faculty/administrators and retired employees may be nominated.

Nominations will be reviewed by the appropriate faculty committee and a recommendation for approval of the nominees will be made to the Board of Regents.
