# JOHN DEERE CREDIT SCHOLARSHIP

**A TUITION SCHOLARSHIP WORTH \$9,000 OVER A FOUR-YEAR PERIOD AND  
A TWO-YEAR PAID WORK EXPERIENCE WITH JOHN DEERE CREDIT**

The John Deere Credit Scholarship is sponsored by the John Deere Credit Company and awarded to two students from *Des Moines or Waterloo public schools* each year. Following completion of their first year, John Deere Credit Scholars must maintain a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.7 and select a major related to, but not limited to, business, marketing, accounting and/or information technology. Following completion of the second year of college, students will receive a summer paid work experience at John Deere Credit in Des Moines. **Deadline for application is April 1.**

## **TO QUALIFY**

- Candidates must be seniors graduating in the spring of the current academic year.
- Candidates must rank in the upper half of their graduating class, attain an ACT score of 19 or higher, and have a grade point average (GPA) of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Recipients must live on campus.
- **Candidates must have applied and been accepted for admission to Wartburg prior to the April 1 deadline.**

- Complete the application form on the reverse side of this sheet.
- List your community and co-curricular activities on a separate sheet. Include awards and honors you have received as well as volunteer and leadership positions you have held.
- Enclose two recommendations. One should be from a high school teacher of a core subject area. The other should be from a person unrelated to you who has known you outside the classroom through employment, church, activities, community service, athletics, etc.
