Required: MFA in Graphic Design or related field. Candidates will also contribute to teaching in the Wartburg Plan of Essential Education and support the mission of the College.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Teach seven undergraduate courses per year, 4-4-1 academic calendar, primarily in graphic design, serving both Communication Design and Communication Arts majors; service to the College through academic advising, curriculum development, student recruitment, and committee membership; engage in professional research/scholarship related to discipline and to the teaching and learning environment.
