

How to access your Network Attached Storage (NASCAR) from a web browser

- 1. Open your web browser.** This may be Internet Explorer (the blue E), Netscape, Safari, Mozilla, Opera, or any sufficiently modern browser. For the purpose of this document, a “sufficiently modern browser” is defined as anything more recent than **Internet Explorer 4.0** (which was made in 1996).
- 2. Make your connection to NASCAR.** Direct your browser to <http://nascar.wartburg.edu/firstname.lastname/> where you would replace **firstname.lastname** with your Wartburg network logon account name. For example, if your name is John Smith, your network logon account name is probably **john.smith** – therefore, the URL you would enter into your browser to access your NASCAR storage would look like the following: <http://nascar.wartburg.edu/john.smith/>
- 3. Your web browser will ask you for your user name and password.** You will most likely see a dialog which looks similar to one of the figures on the following page. To access your NASCAR storage, you must enter your user name like so: **wartburg\firstname.lastname** unless your web browser presents you with an additional space titled “Domain”. In this case, you will simply enter **firstname.lastname** for your user name and **wartburg** for the domain. You will enter your Wartburg network account password in the password space. Click on “OK” when you have entered this information.
- 4. If all went well, you should now have access to your NASCAR storage!**

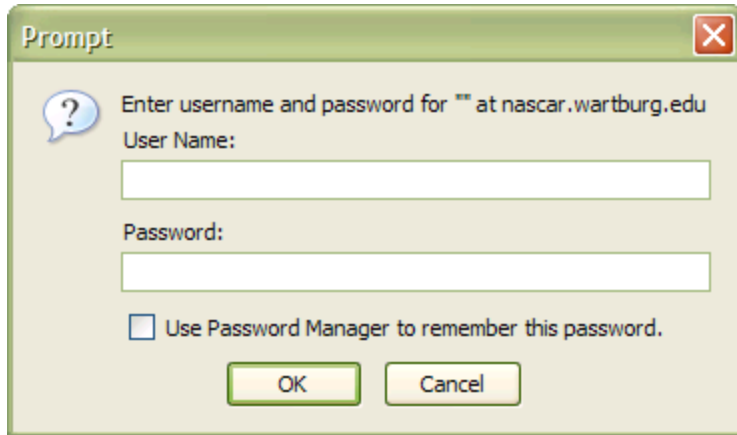


Figure 1. A Mozilla Firefox password request dialog.

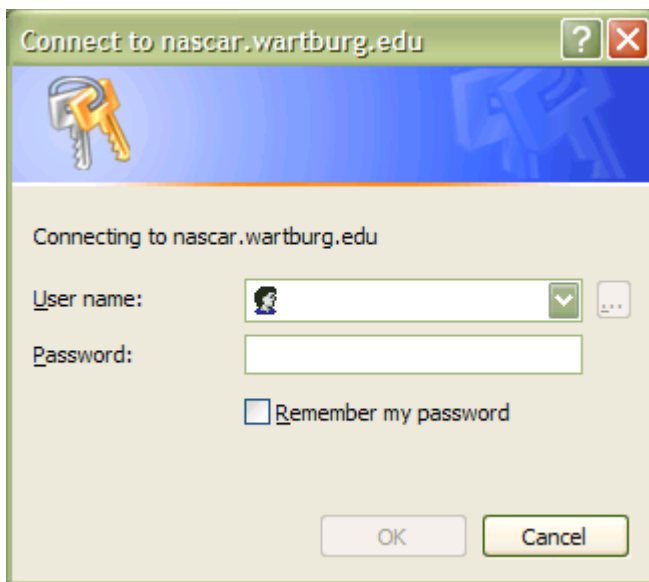


Figure 2. A Password request dialog on Windows XP using Internet Explorer.
