

1. Open Internet Connect from the Applications folder.

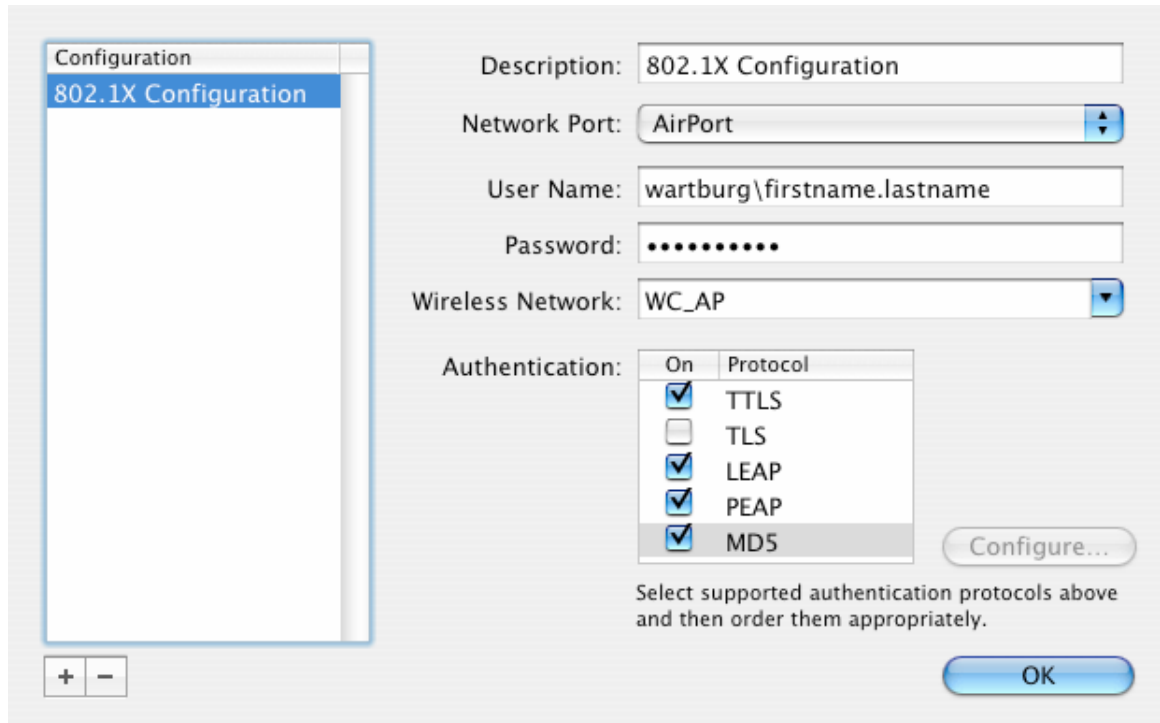


2. Click on the configuration pull down menu and select Edit Configurations...




3. Click on 802.1x Configuration if it is not highlighted. Network type should be set to AirPort. User Name should be set to wartburg\firstname.lastname (your Wartburg user name). Enter your password. The Wireless Network should be WC_AP. Make sure TTLS, LEAP, PEAP and MD5 are all selected. Finally

click on OK.



4. Click on the AirPort button on the top of the Internet Connect box. Make sure the “Show AirPort status in menu bar” check box is selected.



5. Go to File and Quit out of Internet Connect. You should now have a  in your Apple menu at the top of the screen. Click on it and click on WC_AP. If OS X wants permission to use the 802.1x Configuration from your keychain,

select always allow. It will say authenticating for a while and when it is connected it will look like this. 

6. Every time you want to use this network after you have shut down your machine you will have to reconnect to it using step 5.
7. If you have any problems after setting up your preferences, please try rebooting to save your changes.
