

2012 MEISTERSINGER ALL-STATE CAMP INFORMATION SHEET

Wednesday-Friday, August 1-3 OR Saturday-Monday, August 4-6, 2012

- Check-in:** Check-in will be held from 11:00 AM – 12:30 PM on Wednesday, August 1, or Saturday, August 4, in the foyer of Neumann Auditorium.
- Rehearsals:** Rehearsals and sectionals will be held beginning at 1:00 PM in Neumann Auditorium. Rehearsals and sectionals are mandatory. The objective of the camp is to have your music learned by the taping on the final day of camp at 11:00 AM.
- Music:** The camp does not provide the All-State music. This should be obtained through your vocal director.
- Activities:** After the evening rehearsals we will have karaoke and a dance from 8:45-11:30 PM both nights.
- Housing:** The dorms we have been assigned are not air-conditioned so we recommend you bring a fan. Linens are not provided. Leave your valuables at home. The camp will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Meals:** **Camper registration** includes the following meals: dinner on the first day of camp, breakfast, lunch, and dinner on the second day of camp, and breakfast on the last day of camp.
Commuter registration includes the following meals: dinner on the first day of camp, and lunch and dinner on the second day of camp.
- Supervision:** A counselor is assigned to each dormitory floor. Students are required to be in their assigned room for bed check at 12:00 midnight. Any students not in their rooms will be reported to the coordinator of the camp and director/parents will be notified.
- Dress:** Please dress according to the guidelines of your school dress code.

- Cars:** Parking will be available to students commuting to and from the camp. Students are expected to use their cars only for going home at the end of the day.
- Alcohol, Drugs, Fireworks, etc.:** Any students caught with alcohol, drugs, or fireworks of any kind during the camp will be dismissed immediately with no refund. Your director and/or parents will be asked to come and remove you from the campus. Candles and incense are not allowed in dorm rooms. Any items found will be confiscated and not returned. Any inappropriate items causing disruption at the camp and in rehearsals will be confiscated and could lead to dismissal from the camp.
- Damages:** Students will be responsible for the cost of any damages they cause to college property. A \$30 fee will be assessed to students not returning dorm room keys.
- Actions Constituting Dismissal:**
1. **Having drugs, alcohol, cigarettes, fire works or weapons of any kind on campus.**
 2. **Disrupting rehearsals**
 3. **Theft**
 4. **Destruction of property**
 5. **Non-commuters leaving in cars after rehearsals**
 6. **Missing rehearsals and sectionals without permission.**
