



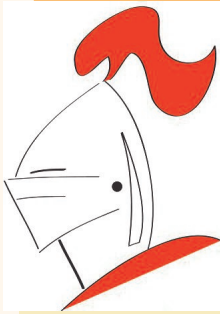

## 5 STEPS TO BECOMING A SENATOR

1 Visit the Senate website ([www.wartburg.edu/senate](http://www.wartburg.edu/senate)).

2 Fill out or print an application.

3 Attend the campaign meeting to learn the election rules.

4 Start campaigning! Make posters and meet the people in your res hall!

5 Voting will occur roughly one week after campaigning starts via email. Elected senators will be notified after voting ends.

### So what do Senators do?

- Attend weekly Senate meetings held on Thursday community time in WBC 214 (Buckmaster). (Everyone is welcome!)
- Work in issue-specific committees.
- Meet with other Senators in your residence hall to host events and make changes.

### BE PART OF HISTORY

Each year Senate is responsible for initiating change on the Wartburg Campus. Over the past years Student Senate has been successful for lobbying for issues such as:

- Academic and res hall recycling and green initiatives
- Technology improvements including campus wireless
- Campus-wide volunteer and issue movements
