

## **SI Leadership for Credit**

Supplemental Instruction Leaders may elect to earn academic credit (.5 course credits per term, repeatable) for their work as SI leaders in lieu of earning work-study wages.

If the SI Leader, the SI Faculty Member, and the SI Supervisor agree that this experience will be for credit, the SI Leader should register for (fill in the appropriate department prefix here) 399: Supplemental Instruction: subject.

For example, an SI leader for Principles of Accounting I (AC 121) may earn credit by registering for AC 399: Supplemental Instruction: Accounting.

Both the professor of the course that is being supported by SI and the SI Supervisor should be listed as instructors for this course and they should collaborate on expectations and grading for the SI Leader.
