Single Room Proposal

Thank you for your interest in Löhe Hall. Löhe Hall is made up of thirty-six three to eight person suites and six single rooms. Each suite in Löhe Hall commits to a yearlong education project. These education projects focus on a topic of the suite's choice, and must be connected to Wartburg's educational mission and vision.

To maintain this education-focused environment throughout the building, students living in the one-person rooms will be expected to develop bulletin board displays throughout the year. These bulletin board displays will highlight educational topics relevant to the Wartburg and Waverly communities. These topics can range from a specific community issue to an issue impacting the entire nation, and ultimately are decided by you.

You will be expected to develop two bulletin boards during Fall Term, two bulletin boards during Winter Term, and one bulletin board during May Term - for a yearlong total of five. You will not be expected to financially contribute to the development of these bulletin boards - materials will be provided throughout the entire year.

Students living in the one-person rooms will be expected to meet monthly with the Löhe Project Coordinator. These meetings will be designed to help you develop a better understanding of how educating others fits into your Wartburg experience.

Proposals are due by 4:30 p.m. on Friday, February 25th and should be submitted via email to leah.king@wartburg.edu. A committee made up of faculty and staff will evaluate the proposals and determine the selection. You will be notified on Friday, March 19 of the committee's decision through correspondence in your campus mailbox. Individuals not selected will still have the opportunity to go through the regular housing process.
